Rose man charged in slaying of mother

William Wilkerson, 30, of Rose reportedly called Mayes County 911 this morning to confess that he stabbed his mother -- and he was booked into jail this afternoon on a charge of first-degree murder.

The name of the victim was not yet known to Investigator Albert McKee of the Mayes County Sheriff's Department, who was at the office and not at the crime scene when contacted.

"They got into an argument and he stabbed her twice that we know of," said McKee about the incident that occurred in the 6500 block of County Road 446 South, near Rose.

"She was stabbed once in the neck and I'm not sure of the other," said McKee in reference information related to the 911 call at about 11:30 a.m.

Mayes County lawmen had just finished burying their K9 dog that died under mysterious circumstances when the homicide call arrived.
